he Hauck name came to this area through Paul Hauck. Paul was born July 1, 1864 in Eichelburg, Germany to Daniel and Barbara nee Dietritz Hauck. His parents brought him and his sisters to Frankenmuth in 1867. His sisters were Barbara Loesel and

Elizabeth Bierlein, and a stepsister, Elizabeth Weiss.

On May 24, 1884, Paul Hauck married Anna Rummel. They had eleven children, two of whom died at birth.

Teckla Schmitzer was born February 22, 1895. Bertha Schultz was born December 5, 1897. Herman was born February 28, 1899. Richard was born April 19, 1900. Lewis was born June 18, 1902. Martin was born October 31, 1905. Martha Ross was born March 14, 1907. Herbert was born February 19, 1909. Frederick was born June 5, 1911.

Paul and Anna farmed on Dehmel Road in Birch Run Township.

Martin Hauck was a well-known and respected carpenter. He built many homes in Frankenmuth. He was very active in Christ Lutheran Church in Birch Run, serving as council member. He was also a member of the Birch Run Village Council where he served as trustee for a number of years.

Martha Hauck Ross, at thirteen years of age in 1920, became the church organist at Christ Lutheran Church in Birch Run. She provided piano and organ music for church worship services and special events for fifty-one years until she retired in 1971, due to poor eyesight. She played for the weddings of all of her brothers and sisters. At age 88, she was still very active in her church as a member of the Ladies Aid and the Senior Citizen Retirees Club.

Several of Paul Hauck's grandchildren became public school teachers: Pat Muehlenbeck, daughter of Martin Hauck; Carol Larson, daughter of Herbert Hauck; and James, son of Martin Hauck, who also served four years as Taymouth Township Supervisor and then as Treasurer.

Marvin Hauck, son of Lewis Hauck, taught in the Cass City High School for two years and then came to Frankenmuth High School. Marvin was a teacher from 1962-1966, and then Principal of Frankenmuth High School from 1966-1972. From 1972-1994, Marvin was Assistant Superintendent for Personnel at Bridgeport-Spaulding Community Schools. He also worked as Field Placement coordinator at Saginaw Valley State University. Marvin married Barbara nee Beyerlein Hauck. They had three children.

Frederick K. Hauck, son of Frederick O., was an excellent baseball player during his high school years. Fred was asked to try out for the Detroit Tigers at the end of his senior year. Although he never made the Tiger team, he went on to devote fourteen years to coaching Little League baseball. He married Edna Pickelman who worked as Front Desk Manager at the Bavarian Inn Lodge in Frankenmuth. They had two sons.

Paul and Anna Hauck's grandchildren number twentyfive as of the year 2005.
